

# **Tonic Decorative Front**

Installation & Operating Instructions

CAUTION! Do not install damaged components.



#### CONTENTS:

Verify and remove contents from packaging before beginning installation.




Figure 1. Tonic Decorative Front

#### Installation Instructions

- 1. Remove primary fireplace glass assembly from fireplace. Place the glass assembly on the box in which the decorative front was packaged.




Figure 2. Location of Mesh Clips.

- 2. Locate the four slots in the glass frame assembly. These will correspond to four mesh clips on the mesh frame assembly. See Figure 2.




Figure 3. Mesh Clips Installed.

- 3. Snap the four mesh clips into the four corresponding slots in the glass frame assembly. See Figure 3. Ensure that the mesh frame assembly is installed tightly on glass so that the spline is projecting outward from the fireplace. See Figure 2.
- 4. Reinstall glass/mesh assembly into fireplace and engage glass clips.




Figure 4. Location of Rivnuts Right and Left Side of Fireplace Opening.

- 5. Install all four fasteners, but do not tighten completely.
- Install the door into the fireplace opening. Note the
  orientation of the door brackets. The slots in the
  bracket will only line up with the rivnuts in the fireplace if the door is installed correctly. See Figure 4.




Figure 5. Screws Installed.

- 7. Push front towards fireplace while holding decorative front firmly in place and tightening the top two left and right screws, followed by the bottom two left and right screws. See Figure 5.

Removing and Replacing Fixed Glass Assembly WARNING! Risk of Asphyxiation! Handle fixed glass assembly with care. Inspect the gasket to ensure it is undamaged and inspect the glass for cracks, chips or scratches.

- DO NOT strike, slam or scratch glass.
- DO NOT operate fireplace with glass removed, cracked, broken or scratched.
- · Replace as a complete assembly.

### **Removing Fixed Glass Assembly**

- 1. Remove the decorative front.
- 2. Locate the two spring latches that are on the upper left and right of the fireplace.
- 3. Use both index fingers to release spring latches.
- 4. Allow glass to tilt forward. Grasp glass on the upper right and left sides and lift glass "up" and "out."

#### Replacing Fixed Glass Assembly

- 1. Grasp glass on upper right and left sides and tilt bottom of glass assembly toward fireplace.
- 2. Allow of the bottom gasketing of the glass assembly to touch the face of the fireplace.
- 3. Put pressure on the glass as you allow the glass assembly to drop into the two lower glass clips.
- 4. Tilt top of glass towards fireplace and engage both top spring latches.




Figure 5. Dimensions of Tonic Decorative Front.

## Model: XLR-CE, XLR-AU, XLR-PLUS

#### **Mesh Instructions**




Figure 7. Glass and Heat Shield

1. Install upper and lower glass heat shields in glass frame assembly as shown in Figure 7.




Figure 8. Install Mesh Bracket

2. Line up holes on mesh brackets with pilot holes on mesh. Install mesh brackets to Mesh panel with 4 screws included as shown in Figure 8.




Figure 9. Install Mesh Assembly

3. Install mesh assembly into door opening such that it rests on the bottom two glass plates. See Figure 9.




Figure 10. Mesh Installation

- 4. Place mesh into position with retaining bolts removed. See Figure 10.




Figure 11. Do Not Tighten Screws

- 5. Install 2 Phillips screws into the 2 riv nut holes on the left and right sides of the fireplace opening Fig 10. Do not tighten screws. See Figure 11.
- 6. Thread retaining bolts into mating threads to retain mesh as shown. See Figures 10 and 11.




Figure 12. Install Front on Mounting Bracket




Figure 13. Install Front on Mounting Bracket

 Install Tonic front as shown below. The mounting bracket on the Tonic door slide between the mesh brackets and the left and right side of the fireplace opening Fig 12 & 13.

5. Slide Tonic front towards the fireplace.




Figure 14. Front Installation




Figure 15. Tighten Phillips Screws

6. Tighten the 4 phillips screws to secure the Tonic front to the fireplace Fig 15.




Figure 16. Tonic Front Gap

### **Cleaning Instructions for Fronts**

Use a microfiber cloth and Windex® Original Glass Cleaner or 03M003 Stove Bright® Glass Cleaner to clean the front immediately after installation to remove acids deposited by the installer or technician. Spray the cleaner onto the microfiber cloth and carefully wipe the entire surface. The front should be cleaned in this manner annually by the homeowner to remove fingerprints or other contaminants. Once oxidation of the paint pigment has occurred, cleaning will not restore the original color.
